The City of Deerfield Beach and the Deerfield Beach Historical Society celebrate Art Stroll (once known as the Festival of the Arts) on Saturday and Sunday, February 13th & 14th, from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Saturday and 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Sunday. The show will take place ON THE BEACH – SOUTH OF THE PIER. The Stroll is held outdoors with the backdrop of ocean breezes and the deep blue sea. The 2026 attendance was over 10,000 and is anticipated to increase due to additional marketing and customer satisfaction ratings.

Deerfield Beach is located in the northern-most part of Broward County, thus drawing crowds from Ft. Lauderdale, Pompano, Boca Raton, Delray Beach, and West Palm Beach. The re-branded Art Stroll is produced by the Deerfield Beach Historical Society in conjunction with the City of Deerfield Beach. The DFB HS supports and promotes the arts and culture in the Deerfield Beach area through our Cultural Center at 84 SE 4th Ave., DFB, FL.

Along with the large variety of artists from all over the United States, the Stroll includes a variety of local restaurants as food vendors, continuous and live musical entertainment, a children's art contest and booths sponsored by local charitable organizations.

Special attention to the artists' needs is a continuing priority. Complimentary water will be served throughout the Stroll and will be available to vendors at the Main Beach Parking Lot. Cell phone numbers will be provided to each artist so that help and information is only a phone call away. Artist parking is well designated and conveniently located adjacent to the Art Stroll grounds. Please note that RVs will be accommodated, however they will be located at nearby Pioneer Park (501 NE Eller Street). All RVs must park between the designated parking signs at Pioneer Park and be self-sufficient. Artist set up begins on Friday, February 12 from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM and early Sat load in from 5AM to 8AM with NO vehicles after 7:30AM. Friendly and helpful staff will be there to assist and direct you.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Exhibit spaces measure approximately 10'x10'. Space may not be shared. Only one artist to one booth space.
2. Any commercially reproduced prints or photographs may not compose more than 10% of any artist booth and must be labeled as commercial reproductions. Final interpretation and enforcement of this rule will be made by the Committee.
3. All paintings, photographs, watercolors, etc. must be appropriately framed or displayed in a portfolio.
4. Artists must provide their own means of display, sturdy enough to withstand crowds, wind and weather. The event is held on city streets which means there can be no penetration of the asphalt. We suggest sandbags or weights.
5. Awards and ribbons from previous shows are not to be displayed.
6. Each artist must individually comply with all Florida sales tax regulations and mail your proceeds to the State of Florida Department of Revenue.
7. Every artist is responsible for his own property in the event of loss, damage or personal injury.
8. For judging purposes, a display card will be supplied bearing the artists name, space number, category and city of residence.
9. Artists must be with their displays during judging. Artists must show their work both days in order to be eligible for an award. Judging will begin at 10:00 AM on Saturday, February 13th.
10. Artists must exhibit during scheduled show hours. Leaving early will make the artist ineligible for admission to future shows. "No Shows" will not be allowed to return.

11. An application is a commitment to the show; however, refunds will be made for cancellation if received prior to February 1, 2027. Phone (954) 429-0378 or e-mail stroll@deerfield-history.org.
12. All work must be created by the exhibitor. The Committee reserves the right to reject any unsuitable work, to remove an exhibit, or ask an exhibitor to leave the show without a refund of the fee.
13. Further details regarding rules and complete instructions will be e-mailed to all artists accepted to the Stroll.
14. No buy/sell merchandise allowed.
15. There are no refunds on deposits or cancellations of the event due to rain or acts of nature.
16. The booth fee for a 10x10 space is \$300. End spaces are limited. There is an additional \$100 charge for an end space, totaling \$400 plus the jury fee of \$25. **The end space fee will only be collected upon awarded space and staff will contact the applicant for the \$100 payment.**
17. Applications must be accompanied by a \$25 non-refundable jury fee. The booth space fee is due when the artist is accepted. The corner space fee will only be collected upon the artist being awarded the space and staff will contact the applicant for the \$100 payment. Please pay through PayPal or mail a check to Deerfield Beach Historical Society, PO Box 755, Deerfield Beach FL 33441.
18. Electric is NOT included. A small, quiet generator is permitted.
19. If exhibiting more than one medium, slides or pictures must be submitted for each.



GENERAL INFORMATION (Continued)

20. Three digital photos and one of display must be submitted for the category entered. Each image must have name, medium, size and arrow indicating top and front. Digital photos may be submitted as attachments to your e-mail sent to stroll@deerfield-history.org. Decisions of the screening committee are final. When you submit your application & pictures, please follow up with an additional email to stroll@deerfield-history.org to insure they have been received. Some files are too large and will not go through.
21. Application return deadline is January 4th. Notification to accepted artists will be by via e-mail the week of January 11th. **All jury fee checks will be deposited on receipt. Checks from accepted artists will not be deposited until the artist has been accepted.**
22. Stroll etiquette mandates that artists' booths remain open until 5:00 PM on Saturday and 5:00 PM on Sunday. Please bring the necessary tools to your booth on Sunday to facilitate your breakdown and be considerate when retrieving your vehicles after 5:00 PM on Sunday.
23. You may be asked to show receipt of raw materials dated within the last 12 months.
24. Clean-up is a must.
